




Extended character support

Turning on extended character support for reports Contact Species 360 Support

Some languages require extended character support. You must turn the Arial Unicode MS font on in Institutional preferences in order to support these characters in reports.



Institutional preferences->Language, Date/Time and Separator Formats-> Check to Support Extended Character Set

Languages that may use extended characters:

- Central Europe languages: Albanian, Croatian, Czech, Hungarian, Polish, Romanian, Serbian (Latin), Slovak, Slovenian
- Cyrillic languages: Azeri, Belarusian, Bulgarian, FYRO Macedonian, Kazakh, Kyrgyz, Mongolian, Russian, Serbian, Tatar, Ukrainian, Uzbek
- Greek
- Turkic languages: Azeri (Latin), Turkish, Uzbek (Latin)
- Hebrew
- Arabic, Farsi, Urdu
- Baltic languages: Estonian, Latvian, Lithuanian
- Vietnamese
- Thai
- Asian languages in general
