ZIPPING THROUGH ZIMS!





When you are in the Animals module the statistics tab displays the most recent animal records that you have been in. It displays the GAN, Taxonomy and Local ID. If you have recorded a photo it also helps you to make sure you are in the correct record as seen in the gila monster photos above.



You are not limited to just the most recent six records! Using the radio buttons or arrows you can quickly locate up to 30 Recent Animal records!



The Statistics tab also displays the most Recent Searches that you have done, allowing you to re-run the search without re-entering all the filters!
