

A: You don't have to know the entire taxonomic name to find it! Just get it started and ZIMS will find it for you!

- The Taxonomy field in ZIMS is a Type Ahead lookup. As you type the application will search for the closest matches to select from.
- However, if you make a mistake along the way you may get the message "There are no results for your search key."
- Just because you don't know how to spell the entire taxonomic name doesn't mean you can't find it in ZIMS.
- Type in the first few letters of the Genus and Species (with a space between) and ZIMS will find it for you!
- This also works in treatment lookup to make finding drugs fast and easy.

■ When searching for Taxonomy you can start typing and ZIMS will find some matches for you. You think you know the taxonomy so you start typing. Several birds and an insect are displayed.


But you make a mistake with the next ► letter so there are no results found.





■ However, typing just the first few letters of the Genus and Species will find the Chilean flamingos you are looking for!
