Sharing Medical Records

You are contacted by an institution that is experiencing some medical problems with their raptor collection. The symptoms sound very much like an issue you had, and were able to successfully resolve, with one of your owls used in education programs.

You are both Gold Level Medical Sharing ZIMS institutions, meaning all medical records are shared and not filtered once sharing is assigned for a record. You select to share the medical record for the owl with your colleague. He reviews the symptoms, diagnosis and treatments that you provided to your owl. He calls you a month later to let you know that the two affected hawks are doing much better thanks to the information provided in your medical records for the owl.




