Data Sharing: Key to Animal Husbandry and Conservation Success!

Species Holding

Your institution specializes in amphibian species from around the world. You have had great success with breeding most of the species except for one – the White's tree frog (*Litoria caerulea*). You want to find out if any other institutions have successfully bred the species so you can get some information about their success.

Using Species Holding functionality in ZIMS you find that of the 155 institutions in six regions that hold White's tree frogs, only one has had hatches in the last 12 months – the Moscow Zoo. Selecting the hyperlink for the five unknown sex animals takes you to a grid for the results. Using the Animal ID GAN hyperlink you can open the record and confirm that these frogs were Captive Born at Moscow Zoo.

By using the hyperlink to the Moscow Zoo from either within the animal record or the Species Holding results grid you find the phone and

fax number as well as the email and website information. You contact the zoo and are able to get the information you need to help you gain success in reproducing this species.




